Caravan check list @ the campsite

Avoid accidents, don't rush next time you are about to hit the road.

Use this handy checklist to ensure your safety is top priority.

- Ensure all items inside the van are secure, put everything away on the bench tops. If your fridge isn't automated select 12 volt for travelling
- Close all the windows and wind down hatches and aerials
- Lock caravan entry door
- Turn off the LP gas
- Take a walk around the van, check - all windows are closed, wheel chocks are removed, the corner stabiliser legs are raised and secure and the entry step has been put up.
- Take a step back to enable you to see the roof and check to ensure that the aerial and hatches have been wound down
- Scan your eyes over the coupling to ensure it is properly connected
- Safety chains and the break-away wire are secure
- Trailer plug is plugged in
- Remove jockey wheel
- Release the handbrake
- Test the brake lights and indicators to make sure that they are in good working order
- Check tyre pressure of tow vehicle and caravan
- You can now head off on your trip
